## EN IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ BEFORE USE AND KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

Thank you for choosing this Carramio Baby Carrier which is the perfect way to carry your baby close to you whilst you both explore or shop together.

This carrier is designed to carry a baby from 3.5kg up to 9kg (approx. 7lb 11oz to 19lb 13oz).

### FIRST FITTING - WITHOUT BABY

Before using for the first time, try the Baby Carrier on without your baby and make sure that it is comfortable and secure. Get a friend or partner to help if necessary.

1. Pass the shoulder straps (1) over your head and clip the buckles (2) together on each side. Evenly adjust both shoulder straps and centre the cross-over buckle (3).

2. Pass the lumbar support (4) around your waist and clip into the buckle (5) at the side. Adjust each side to ensure that the support is in the middle of your back.

### 3. IMPORTANT ADJUSTMENTS

Before putting your baby into the carrier it is important that you adjust the 'touch-and-close' adjusters (6) above the leg holes on both sides to ensure that the leg openings are at their smallest possible size whilst allowing your baby's legs to sit comfortably within. Make sure that at least 50% of each 'touch-and-close' strip overlaps. When these adjustments have been made, tighten the side buckles (7) to ensure a safe and secure fit.

### CARRYING YOUR NEWBORN BABY

4. Whilst seated, release the headrest clips (8) on both sides.

5. Supporting your baby's head, position your baby facing towards you, and lower baby into the open carrier. Carefully pass baby's legs through the fastened leg holes, and arms through the openings above the 'touch-and-close' adjusters.

6. Continuing to support baby's head, reconnect the headrest clips (8) and adjust the straps to ensure that baby's head is well supported.

Important - For your and your baby's comfort, we recommend that the carrier should be positioned high enough for you to kiss the top of baby's head.

### CARRYING YOUR OLDER BABY

From the age of 4 to 6 months, when baby can hold its head upright without support you can switch to carrying baby facing forwards and the headrest can be clipped down.

### REMOVING YOUR CHILD AND TAKING THE BABY CARRIER OFF

Whilst supporting baby's head, release the headrest clips (8) on each side, and lift baby out of the seat.

With baby removed you can remove the baby carrier by releasing the shoulder strap and lumbar support clips and lifting the straps over your head.

EXTRA BIBS - Packs of extra bibs are available online or by calling the Careline.

### SAFETY NOTES:

This baby carrier is intended for use by adults only.

WARNING - Ensure that baby is correctly secured and that the harness is securely fitted in accordance with these instructions.

WARNING - Your balance may be adversely affected by your movement and that of your baby.

WARNING - Take care when bending or leaning forward.

WARNING - This carrier is NOT suitable for use during sporting activities.

WARNING - Always ensure that baby's breathing is not obstructed by the carrier, your own clothing or the removable bib if used.

Regularly check for wear or damage to the carrier. Do not use if damaged.

Regularly check security of straps, buckles and adjusters, particularly after washing or cleaning.

Do not add any accessories to the carrier.

Do not use this carrier if you have a history of back problems and stop using it if you experience any pain or continuing discomfort.

Do not carry your baby in the baby carrier whilst in a car - always use an approved car seat.

Never lie down or sleep whilst your child is in the baby carrier.

### CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Refer to the sewn-in label on the carrier for washing instructions.
